Internships of three months (or more on request) are available at the Villa in Los Angeles. You support the staff in a range of administrative tasks, event management, membership, guided tours and assist the resident artists in their everyday life. Our interns meet and work with interesting people from the arts, culture, politics and academia.

Sensitivity and flexibility in dealing with different personalities and the ability to work within complex institutional structures in a bi-lingual environment are essential. Applicants have to be at least 21 years old.

With your application you agree to submit a final report about your impressions and experience during the internship to both the L.A. and Berlin offices.

Upon acceptance the University of Southern California will process a J-1 travel visa to be picked up from the Embassy in Germany. Visa fees in the US are paid by Villa Aurora, possible fees due in Germany are paid by the intern.
